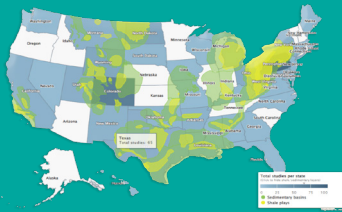

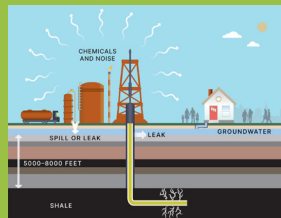
Potential Community Exposures Being Studied in this Program of Research
